

World wide focus on Bobin company

BOBIN based 'The Fodder Factory' is one of nine regional companies in 36 across New South Wales, selected yesterday for world wide promotion.

The NSW Minister for State Development, Michael Egan, announced the 36 companies at the Australian Technology Park in Sydney.

The selected companies, which have locally developed products which are ready for export, will be promoted world wide through the 'Australian Technology Showcase'.

These companies will ultimately be joined by hundreds more from around Australia in being promoted at inter-

national expos as well as through a targeted campaign which will bring international business leaders to Australia in the run up to the Olympic Games.

The Fodder Factory,

operated by Peter Ryan, has designed a food processing plant that produces one tonne of high protein livestock feed a day, using about 1000 litres of any type of water, including bore water.

The invention has been described as a drought breaker.

Each Fodder Factory is a fully contained shed that produces high protein green fodder each day, irrespective of the outside climate.

Peter's factories have been established in such diverse climatic locations as Rockhampton, Dubbo and Hobart.
